John 11:25-26; "I am the Resurrection and the Life. He that believeth in Me, though he were dead, yet shall he live;"

John 14:6; "I am the Way, the Truth, and the Life; no man cometh unto the Father, but by Me."

John 15:1,5; "I am the true vine, and My Father is the husbandman."
