Timothy

Timothy had mixed parents, a Greek father and Jewish mother.

Called also Timotheus, the companion of Paul.

"I Then came he to Derbe and Lystra: and, behold, a certain disciple was there, named Timotheus, the son of a certain woman, which was a Jewess, and believed; but his father was a Greek: "

The Christian faith of Timothy

Acts 16:2

"2 Which was well reported of by the brethren that were at Lystra and Iconium."

1 Cor 4:17

"17 For this cause have I sent unto you Timotheus, who is my beloved son, and faithful in the Lord, who shall bring you into remembrance of my ways which be in Christ, as I teach every where in every church."

1 Cor 16:10

"10 Now if Timotheus come, see that he may be with you without fear: for he worketh the work of the Lord, as I also do."

2 Tim 1:5

Timothy circumcised; Joins with Paul

Acts 16:3

"3 Him would Paul have to go forth with him; and took and circumcised him because of the Jews which were in those quarters: for they knew all that his father was a Greek."

"2 And sent Timotheus, our brother, and minister of God, and our fellow labourer in the gospel of Christ, to establish you, and to comfort you concerning your faith:"

Timothy is left by Paul at Berea

Acts 17:14

"14 And then immediately the brethren sent away Paul to go as it were to the sea: but Silas and Timotheus abode there still."

Timothy rejoins Paul at Corinth

Acts 17:15

"15 And they that conducted Paul brought him unto Athens: and receiving a commandment unto Silas and Timotheus for to come to him with all speed, they departed."

Acts 18:5

"5 And when Silas and Timotheus were come from Macedonia, Paul was pressed in the spirit, and testified to the Jews that Jesus was Christ."

Timothy sent into Macedonia

Acts 19:22

" 22 So he sent into Macedonia two of them that ministered unto him, Timotheus and Erastus; but he himself stayed in Asia for a season."

Timothy joined by Paul, then goes with Paul to Asia

Acts 20:1-4

- "1 And after the uproar was ceased, Paul called unto him the disciples, and embraced them, and departed for to go into Macedonia.
 - 2 And when he had gone over those parts, and had given them much exhortation, he came into Greece,
- 3 And there abode three months. And when the Jews laid wait for him, as he was about to sail into Syria, he purposed to return through Macedonia.
- 4 And there accompanied him into Asia Sopater of Berea; and of the Thessalonians, Aristarchus and Secundus; and Gaius of Derbe, and Timotheus; and of Asia, Tychicus and Trophimus."

Sends greetings to the Romans Believers

Timothy is sent to the Corinthian church

1 Cor 4:17

Timothy left by Paul in Ephesus

- 2 To Timothy, my dearly beloved son: Grace, mercy, and peace, from God the Father and Christ Jesus our Lord."
