"Kingdom of power to come"

Continuing our thoughts on our relationship with God and our worship through the words of the Lord's Prayer.

Matthew 6:9,10.

"9 After this manner therefore pray ye: Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name.

10 Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven.

11 Give us this day our daily bread.

12 And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors.

13 And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil: For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, for ever. Amen."

This part of the verse 13 is not found in later copies of the ancient manuscripts, neither is it included in the copy of the Lord's Prayer found in <u>Luke 11:2-4.</u>. As a result the passage does not appear in some translations.

It is necessary that God's people must live in the power of God.

Acts 17 24,25

"24 God that made the world and all things therein, seeing that he is Lord of heaven and earth, dwelleth not in temples made with hands;

25 Neither is worshipped with men's hands, as though he needed any thing, seeing he giveth to all life, and breath, and all things;"

We must have great faith that He knows what to do for the world and each of us personally.

Why, God created all things, knows all things and controls all things. God may not always appear to respond to our requests or desires but if we know Him as our Lord and Father then ultimately it will be the best and right action.

"16 For by him were all things created, that are in heaven, and that are in earth, visible and invisible, whether they be thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: all things were created by him, and for him:

17 And he is before all things, and by him all things consist."

Romans 8:12-19.

"12 Therefore, brethren, we are debtors, not to the flesh to live according to the flesh,

13 for if ye live according to the flesh ye shall die, but if ye through the Spirit do mortify the deeds of the body ye shall live.

14 For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God.

15 For ye have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear, but ye have received the Spirit of adoption, whereby we cry, "Abba! Father!"

16 The Spirit itself bears witness with our spirit that we are the children of God;

17 \P and if children, then heirs--heirs of God and joint heirs with Christ, if so it be that we suffer with Him, that we may be also glorified together.

18 For I reckon that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory which shall be revealed in us.

19 For the earnest expectation of the creature waits for the manifestation of the sons of God."
